

The nature of the activities to be conducted and the purposes to be promoted or carried out by the corporation shall be exclusively charitable, educational, cultural and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and to a public charity under Sections 509 (a) (1) and 509 (a) (2), whichever is applicable, as may be amended from time to time and shall include, but not be limited to the following:

- A. To promote and foster civic events for the Town of Southwick and surrounding towns and communities.
- B. To solicit and receive contributions, grants, donations, gifts, bequests, devises and other sources of funding to promote the purposes of this corporation.
- C. To accept, hold, invest, reinvest, administer any contributions, grants, donations, gifts, bequests and devises received for said purposes.
- D. To enter into agreements and arrangements with such other charitable organizations or groups as the corporation shall determine, to carry out any of the aforesaid purposes of the corporation.
- E. To make distributions to organizations that carry out the purposes above should they qualify as public charities and tax exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code.

In general, to carry on all activities in connection with any of the foregoing purposes, to have and exercise all of the powers conferred upon non-profit corporations under Chapter 180 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, all to the extent not inconsistent with any requirements contained in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the regulations promulgated hereunder, and not inconsistent with any other provisions of the Articles of Organization.
